





Institute of Palliative Medicine, Kozhikode, Kerala- 673 008 (here in after referred to as IPM) represented by its Director

MES Dental College, Palachode P.O. Perinthalmanna, Malappuram D T - 679338. (here in after referred to as MESDC), represented by the Principal Dr Abdul Shameem K, MESDC.

(Both IPM and MESDC are also jointly referred to herein as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS, The Institute of Palliative Medicine, Kozhikode, Kerala- 673 008 which started in 2004. IPM is the pioneer of palliative care movement in South East Asia. As the first World Health Organisation Collaborating Centre for Community Participation in Palliative Care and Long Term Care (WHOCC) in developing countries. IPM is instrumental in developing the "Kerala Model" of palliative care which is popular among the palliative care fraternity worldwide. IPM is the training, research and outreach arm of Pain and Palliative Care Society (PPCS). It is located in the Medical College campus, Kozhikode.

The MES Dental College, run by the Muslim Educational Society (Regd.), Calciut, is The College is approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare New Delhi, Dental Council of India, Government of Kerala and the College is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences. The college is located in the MESAMS campus and is having all the state-of- the art infrastructure facilities excelling all other Dental colleges in Kerala. ARTICLE-I: SCOPE

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following and such similar research areas of mutual interest:

- 1. Joint Research and Development
- 2. Jointly Organizing seminars, workshops, conferences and other academic activities
- 3. Student Internship / observerships
- 4. Conduct of Community Development Programs
- 5. Faculty training / fellowship programmes
- 6. Home care visits

ARTICLE-II: TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

The two parties agree to take part in the joint research initiatives and academic programs as mentioned above in Article I. In the projects identified for collaboration, faculty, students and staff from the two Institutes will collaborate in carrying out the research activity in palliative medicine as proposed in the project proposals approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee of MESDC and IPM (to be added as an Annexure-1) after obtaining all necessary approvals and permissions subscribing to the guidelines applicable. The research proposals will be developed with the collaborative efforts of MESDC and IPM.

IPM will allow student internship/observerships and faculty training and fellowship programs. IPM will collect a nominal fee from students undergoing observership etc as per the policy of the institute however exempting charging of fee from interns under this collaboration.

ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- 1. IPM and MESDC shall make provisions to share their respective important R&D facilities in order to carry out research projects.
- 2. IPM and MESDC shall permit sharing facilities to their premises required to carry out research projects, if permissible within the rules governing the two organizations.
- 3. IPM and MESDC shall provide access to the library facilities to personnel of both the organizations involved in the projects as per the applicable rules and norms.



ARTICLE-IV: RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH PARTY

Responsibilities of MESDC

- 1. MESDC will refer patients to IPM for further palliative care, as required for the collaborative projects.
- 2. MESDC will also provide all required support in terms of data and de-identified clinical information which shall come to help in the research projects.
- 3. MESDC will obtain all necessary permissions, approvals and certification, including informed consents and assure strict compliance with all ethical and legal mandates and follow all national and international guidelines including that of Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) for collaborative research.
- 4. The faculty and researchers in MESDC related to their research projects will visit IPM to have discussions and periodic monitoring of the progress of the research. The mutual visits will be done with prior discussion and appointments.

Responsibilities of IPM Calicut

- 1. IPM will allow access to de-identified patient's clinical data for the conduct of research and provide necessary reports for the research purpose following Ethical Committee approval.
- 2. IPM will also facilitate visits of faculty and students in MESDC to IPM for observership and training programmes and research based on palliative medicine.
- 3. IPM will also obtain all necessary permissions, approvals and certification, including informed consents and assure strict compliance with all ethical and legal mandates and follow all national and international guidelines including that of Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) for collaborative research.

ARTICLE-V: ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

- 1. All the activities under academic collaboration in this article will be subjected to the appropriate approval from the Director of IPM and competent authorities and official bodies.
- 2. Faculty from MESDC will be invited to handle selected topics in the courses of programmes offered by IPM.
- 3. Faculty from IPM will be invited to handle selected topics in the courses of programmes offered by MESDC.
- 4. Joint research and academic guidance in palliative care between MESDC and IPM.
- 5. Joint Internship and training will be provided at MESDC and IPM for students from MESDC as per need, as per the applicable rules and norms, and with prior permission.

ARTICLE-VI: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MoU

- 1. This MoU shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends.
- 2. The duration of the MoU shall be for a period of three years from the effective date.
- 3. This MoU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than threeMonths by either party.
- 4. However, termination of the MoU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted to pursue a programme under this MoU, and the same shall be subjected to the final decision of the heads of the respective institutions.
- 5. The progress of the research will be reviewed periodically and necessary measures will be taken to address the challenges and to take it forward.
- 6. If any of the partner institution wishes to terminate the MOU at the end of the stipulated period (3 years) it must notify the other institution not less than three months prior to the expiry of the MoU.

ARTICLE-VII: IPR

Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, etc. under the scope of this MoU shall be equally shared between IPM and MESDC, with mutual consent between the two parties.

ARTICLE-VIII: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenancy of the MoU, both IPM and MESDC will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the confidential information and data exchanged under the scope of this MoU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MoU.

'CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION' shall mean any proprietary information, data or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored , which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions .

Confidentiality of patient related information will be given prime importance as suggested by the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC) of MESDC and IPM. No data related to patients will be used out of the purview of this research and all patient identifiers will be masked.

Both IPM and MESDC shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or projects.

Further, both IPM and MESDC shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use. This clause shall survive the termination or expression to the first the state of t

ARTICLE- IX: AMENDMENTS

Any Article of clause of the MoU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of MESDC and IPM. Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be in writing and signed by both the parties hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the MoU.

ARTICLE-X: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India.

If dispute or difference whatsoever arises between the Parties in relation to or in connection with this MoU, both the parties shall first try to resolve the dispute/difference amicably between themselves failing which the matter shall be resolved through arbitration and the place of arbitration shall be Calicut.
