Introduction

Our goal is to be one of the top five dental colleges of choice for students to seek admission in the state of Kerala providing oral health awareness and cost effective treatment to social economically deprived communities of the district of Malappuram

We have set our long term goals with an analysis of the needs of society and assessing our strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges ahead to meet the needs of the society.

Report of the technical group on population projection issue by Department Health & Family welfare dated July 2020, states that Kerala has got more elderly population than the rest of the nation and projects an increase in elderly population by 2036.

The Economic review released in 2021 by Government of Kerala states that:

Malappuram has a lower per capita income compared to the State average. And In absolute number, Malappuram district has the highest child population (5, 74,041) compared to the state average.

Physically and mentally challenged populations seeking dental treatment become an issue as most dental clinics are positioned in the first floors of commercial spaces, perhaps due to the financial obligation and space availability. Our initial survey has also shed light on the lack of clear cut guidelines in dental clinics to support physically challenged patients.

Though the state has established 30 dental colleges and a mushrooming number of dental clinics, the 'preventive approach' in dental treatment is missing, and mostly limited to 'problem' issue based 'treatment.

Though the general public is aware of dentistry, the concept of 'precautions for prevention' and 'in time treatment' seems lacking or is seen as a lower need, in their priority ladder.
