

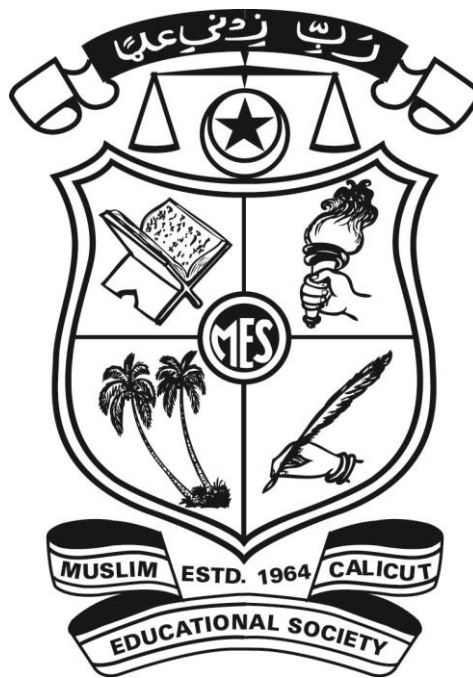

The annual intake of the college is 100 seats in BDS course. The college has acquired the prestigious status of a Post Graduate Dental institute with PG Degree courses in Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge (6 seats) , Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics (6 seats), Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery (6 seats), Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics (6 seats). Pediatrics and Preventive Dentistry (3 seats), Periodontics (3 seats). The college is located in the MESAMS campus and is having all the state-of- the art infrastructure facilities excelling all other Dental colleges in Kerala and is attached to MES Medical College Hospital. The College building comprises of four stories with total floor area of 1,70,000 sq.ft. Classes are supervised and administered by highly qualified and experienced faculty members. A well equipped Mobile Dental Clinic and fully equipped and functional Satellite centers at Pattikkad and Pandikkad is also extending services to the public..

INTRODUCTION

1. This prospectus relates to admission to BDS course for the academic year 2026-27 in MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna.
2. This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to BDS Course in MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna for the academic year 2026-27
3. This Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna and will be subject to further orders, if any, passed by appropriate authorities/ Courts of law.
4. Total number of seats available for admission to BDS Course in accordance with this prospectus and the categories into which such admission would be made, are given in Annexure I below

5. Duration of Courses

Duration of the Course is 4 ½ years with a compulsory rotating internship of 12 months programme. Internship training will include outreach community programmes and rotation postings of interns in the hospitals/health centres of the Muslim Educational Society.

Important: As per NDC Public Notice No. F.No.NDC/UGPG-DEB/BDS/Genletter/M-2/2026/M-754 dated 03-06-2026 **"Any student who does not clear the BDS Course in all the subjects within a period of 9 years, including one year Compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course". •**

I. CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTION SCHEDULE

1. Nationality:-

Candidates must be Citizens of India/children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The candidates should also satisfy the conditions prescribed in the Prospectus.

2. Age:

He/she shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the BDS Course.

3. Qualification / Academic

- i. Applicants must meet all the requirements stipulated by the NDC and Kerala University of Health Sciences for admission to BDS course.
- ii. "Candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have obtained a minimum of marks at 50th percentile in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for the respective admission year for admission to BDS course. In respect of candidates belonging to the Scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes category the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 50% and minimum marks obtained in 'National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG) shall be at 40th percentile instead of 50th percentile.

Note:

- i. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of the qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences.
- ii. Candidates should possess certificate of good conduct and character issued from the institution last studied.

4. *Schedule of Selection and Admission*

Schedule of Selection and Admission will be as fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala based on the time schedule fixed by the appropriate competent authorities concerned in this regard.

(Note: with regard to the CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND SELECTIONSCHEDULE, you are instructed to visit the website of DCI (<https://dciindia.gov.in/>) and KEAM (www.cee.kerala.gov.in) regularly for updates).

II. HOW TO APPLY

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, Government of India, as per letter dated 10-03-2017 directed the respective state government to conduct Common counseling for admission to UG and PG courses in all medical education institution in their respective state including private medical colleges/Deemed Universities. Hence application for admission to BDS course in the college shall be submitted online to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala, the authority designated by the State Government to conduct counseling for allotment of students, through their official website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

The fees shown above are previous year fee and are subject to revision by the Fee Regulatory Committee for Medical Education in Kerala/appropriate government authorities concerned/Hon'ble Courts of law

Note:

- Tuition fee for the first year shall be paid at the time of admission.
- Besides tuition fees, fees prescribed by the University/other statutory bodies (like exam fee, registration fee, etc.), caution deposit, Hostel & Mess fees & refundable deposit and other fees as may be required (Uniform Fee/Books, Stationery, etc.) shall be paid in addition by the students in actual from time to time.

IV. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

Total seats available for BDS course in the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna will be filled up by the college as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list of eligible candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG-2026) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission to MBBS/BDS course, through common counseling conducted by the CEE as per letter dated 10-03-2017 of the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi.

4.1 Preparation of common Merit list and Allotment of Seats

Rank list will be prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from among the applicant candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility- cum-Entrance Test (NEET UG 2026) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for admission to MBBS/BDS course, based on the NEET rank secured by them in the above examination after observing inter-se merit.

4.2 Publication of rank list and Allotment of Candidates: Rank list of candidates as detailed in clause 4.1 above will be prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and allotment will be done strictly on the basis of inter-se merit from the rank list so prepared.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in MES Dental College and the college shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, documents to be submitted, and the amount of fees to be remitted at the time of admission. The detailed institutional requirement shall be published in the website of the institution from time to time.

4.3 Furnishing of false information:

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, if admitted, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

V. ADMISSION

5.1 Candidates who get allotment shall appear before the Principal of the College and take admission at the appointed time and date in the college and remit tuition fee, admission fee and special fees for the first year. They shall also produce the following documents in original at the time of admission before the Principal of the College.

- a. Admit card of NEET UG-2026.
- b. Result/Score Card of NEET UG-2026.
- c. Allotment Memo & Data Sheet of KEAM 2026
- d. Mark list at the qualifying examination.
- e. Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- f. Document (School Record viz: SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- g. Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE /ISCE.
- h. Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
- i. Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last attended.
- j. Migration Certificate
- k. Copy of Aadhar
- l. A Physical Fitness Certificate in the format given in Annexure III obtained from a Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.
- m. Vaccination Requirement: All students getting selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis, MMR and Chicken pox, before admission. A certificate to this effect will have to be produced at the time of admission
- n. Community/ Minority certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable).
- o. Nativity Certificate
- p. Non-creamy Layer certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable)
- q. Income certificate issued by the competent authority (if applicable).
- r. Originals of other certificates, the copies of which are enclosed with the application form.
- s. Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application form.
- t. Softcopy (PDF Format) and Hard copy (Photocopies) of all the above Documents including fully filled Application form (Except Annexures)
- u. Passport size colour photo -10nos.
- v. Undertaking in Annexure II to be duly notarized in the stamp paper worth of 500/- rupees.
- w. Receipt of Fee Remitted (CEE)
- x. Any other document/ certificate required to be produced.

5.2 Cancellation of admission/Refund of Fees

- (i). No request for refund of fees received within a period of five days prior to the date of closure of admission to the BDS course fixed by the National Dental Commission/any competent authority appointed by the Govt. of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India will be entertained. Refund of fees will be applicable only to students who leave the College on or before five days before the last date for closing of admission for BDS fixed by the National Dental Council. The refund will be made within thirty days of the receipt of request thereof.
- (ii). If any candidate discontinues the course or leaves the Institution within a period of five days before the closing of admission in the 1st year or discontinues the course/leaves the institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e. fees for the whole course. They will have to pay Liquidated damages as stipulated in Clause 12.2.4 of the Government of Kerala Prospectus for Admission to the Professional Degree courses 2026. In such cases the documents in original submitted by the candidate at the time of admission and other documents like Transfer Certificate in original to be issued by the college will be released only after payment of all dues including the fees for the remaining years.
- (iii). In addition to the above, such students will have to pay hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college. For the purpose of calculations of proportionate recovery part of a month will be considered as a full month.

5.3 Ragging

Important : According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.

All institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's, College, Kerala & Ors [with SLP (C) No.24296-99/2004 & W.P.(CrI) No.173/2006 & SLP (C) No.14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honorable Supreme Court of India for effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions.

In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/ she indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/ she shall be expelled from the educational institution.

Each of the student of the institution and his/ her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/ admission in prescribed format available in **Annexure IV** which is mandatory for registration/ admission.

Such an undertaking shall be submitted before the commencement of every academic year. An undertaking similar to the above shall be submitted every year by the student who is admitted to the hostel.

VI. DISCIPLINE

- a. Rules and regulations as prescribed should be strictly followed at the college, hospital and hostels.
- b. Smoking and consumption of alcoholic drinks are totally prohibited.
- c. Hostel accommodation is provided for one year, renewable after assessment of the discipline of the student on a yearly basis.
- d. Daily biometric attendance marking is mandatory for the hostel students, failing to comply with regulations will forfeit their hostel accommodation.
- e. **Uniform & Dress Code:** Students are expected to obey the dress code of the College. Jeans, Baggies, T-Shirts and the likes are not permitted to be worn inside the hospital/College campus. A uniform is prescribed for the students of BDS in the College and the students have to strictly wear the uniform during class hours and clinical postings. The uniform dress material supply and stitching will be done by the college, the cost of which should be borne by the students.

8.1 All the male students are expected to wear formal pants, shirts and shoes. The female students are expected to wear saree and blouse with sleeves / loose fitting churidar with sleeves. They should also wear shawl. No students shall wear face veil or any other garments that completely covers the face and renders personal identification difficult or impossible while on the campus or during institutional activities. All the students should wear overcoat and ID card compulsorily. ***All students shall maintain modesty and decency in their attire while on the Campus. Students are not allowed to attend the classes or participate in academic or institutional activities wearing garments that completely cover their face and prevent proper identification.*** The management reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary action against those who do not comply with the college dress code (vide judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.P.(C).No.35293 of 2018 dated 04- 12-2018).

- f. There will be regular value oriented classes/discussions in the campus. Students are advised to participate in these programmes. This is an institution meant for higher learning and its objective is not only to impart education but also to build the character of the students and transform them into better human beings.
- g. Students are expected to observe absolute discipline in their conduct, dignity and decorum during the entire period they spend in the institution. Failure to observe absolute discipline, dignity and decorum will invite appropriate disciplinary action.

- h. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If it is found during the admission or any time there after that the applicant has indulged in ragging admission shall be refused or the student shall be expelled from the institution. Whoever commits, participate in, abets or propagate ragging within or outside the institution shall be suspended from the institution with immediate effect and the Dean/Principal shall report the matter to the civil/police authorities.

VII. GENERAL

- a) No TA or other allowance will be paid for any purpose connected with Selection and Admission.
- b) All candidates who are selected for admission should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis MMR, Chicken pox before admission. A certificate to this effect will have to be produced at the time of admission/before commencement of the course.
- c) Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college <https://mesdc.edu.in/> regularly for announcements and instructions. No separate communication will be sent in this connection
- d) Medium of instruction will be English.
- e) Any other matters not specifically covered in this Prospectus shall be decided by the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna and the decision of that authority shall be final and binding on all concerned.

VIII. REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES

Any grievances/ complaints regarding selection and admission can be brought to the notice of the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna within 24 hours of occurrence of the grievance.
