The college has acquired the prestigious status of a Post Graduate Dental institute with PG Degree courses in Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge (6 seats), Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics (6 seats), Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery (6 seats), Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics (6 seats). Pediatrics and Preventive Dentistry (3 seats), Periodontics (3 seats). The college is located in the MESAMS campus and is having all the state-of-the-art infrastructure facilities excelling all other Dental colleges in Kerala and is attached to MES Medical College Hospital. The College building comprises of four stories with total floor area of 1,70,000 sq.ft. Classes are supervised and administered by highly qualified and experienced faculty members. ## **I INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This prospectus relates to admission to MDS course for the academic year 2026-27 in MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna.
- 1.2 This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to MDS Course in MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna for the academic year 2026-27
- 1.3 This Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna and will be subject to further orders, if any, passed by appropriate authorities/ Courts of law.

### **1.4 Courses Offered**

### **1.5 Duration of Courses**

Duration of the MDS Course including University Examination is 3 years.

### **1.6 Commencement of course and completion of admission process**

The date of commencement of the Course and the last date of completion of admission process will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Government of India/ the National Dental Commission (NDC)/the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

## **II CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY, PROCEDURE AND SCHEDULE FOR SELECTION AND ADMISSION**

### **2.1. Nationality:-**

Candidates must be Citizens of India/children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The candidates should also satisfy the conditions prescribed in the Prospectus.

### **2.2. Qualification / Academic**

- a) Applicants must meet all the requirements stipulated by the NDC and Kerala University of Health Sciences for admission to MDS course.
- b) Applicants should have passed and possess recognized BDS Degree from an institution duly recognized as per the provisions of the National Dental Commission Act (as amended from time to time) by the competent authority concerned in India.
- c) Applicants shall have to qualify in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Post Graduate) conducted by the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi (An autonomous organisation of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India) on an All-India basis for admission to MDS Courses for academic session 2026-27 [NEET-PG 2026].
- d) The eligibility criteria for admission to NRI category will be as per GO(MS)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, G.O(Rt)No.375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020, G.O.(Rt)No.1556/2024/H&FWD dt.28-06-2024, G.O.(Rt)No.1616/2024/H&FWD dt.04-07-2024, G.O.(Rt)No.650/2025/H&FWD dt.05-03-2025, G.O (Rt) No. 191/2026/H&FWD dtd 13.01.2026, CEE notification No. CEE/263/2026-TA4 dated 02/07/2026 and further orders in this regard, if any, issued by government from time to time
- e) Only applicants who have completed their one year of Compulsory Rotatory Internship of 12 months or are likely to complete the same on or before 31/05/2026 are eligible to apply.

### **2.3 Schedule of Selection and Admission**

Schedule of Selection and Admission will be as fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala based on the time schedule fixed by the appropriate competent authorities concerned in this regard.

### III. HOW TO APPLY

**3.1** The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, Government of India, as per letter dated 10-03-2017 directed the respective state government to conduct Common counseling for admission to UG and PG courses in all medical education institution in their respective state including private medical colleges/Deemed Universities. Hence application for admission to MDS course in the college shall be submitted online to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Government of Kerala, the authority designated by the State Government to conduct counseling for allotment of students, through their official website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

### 3.2 Fee Structure (Provisional)

(The above mentioned fee is provisional and may vary subject to the final decisions of the admission and Fee Regulatory Committee, Courts or appropriate Government authority)

Note:

- a). Tuition fee of the first year shall be paid at the time of admission.
- b). The fees prescribed by the University/other statutory bodies (like administration fee, affiliation fee, exam fee, registration fee, etc.) and tuition fee of the subsequent years shall be paid by the students, in actual, from time to time.
- c). Besides tuition fees, caution deposit, Hostel & Mess fees and refundable deposit and any other fees as may be permitted to be collected will have to be paid extra.
- d). The Annual Tuition Fee is fixed for entire course period taking into the account of existing amount of stipend being given to the Post graduate students. Hence, the amount of stipend will be provided at the rate prevailing at the time of joining by the candidate and shall be applicable for the entire course period. In case, enhancement of amount of stipend if any, is necessitated, the Tuition fee will be subject to revision proportionally.

### IV PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

Total seats available for MDS course in the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna including NRI quota seats will be filled up by the college as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list of eligible candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET PG-2026) through common counseling conducted by the CEE as per letter dated 10-03-2017 of the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi.

#### **4.1 Preparation of common Merit list and Allotment of Seats**

Rank list will be prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from among the applicant candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility- cum-Entrance Test (NEET PG 2026) for admission to MDS course, based on the NEET rank secured by them in the above examination after observing inter-se merit.

#### **4.2 Publication of rank list and Allotment of Candidates:** Rank list of candidates as detailed in clause 4.1 above will be prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and allotment will be done strictly on the basis of inter-se merit from the rank list so prepared and as per the schedule fixed by the National Dental Commission or such dates as may be fixed by the Government of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in MES Dental College and the college shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, documents to be submitted, and the amount of fees to be remitted at the time of admission. The detailed institutional requirement shall be published in the website of the institution from time to time.

#### **4.3 Furnishing of false information:**

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, if admitted, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

## V ADMISSION

Candidates who get allotment shall appear before the Principal of the College and take admission at the appointed time and date in the college and remit tuition fee, admission fee and special fees for the first year. They shall also produce the following documents in original at the time of admission before the Principal of the College.

- (a) Admit card and Score card of NEET PG 2026.
- (b) CEE Allotment Memo and Data sheet
- (c) BDS Pass/Degree Certificate from the concerned University.
- (d) Marks sheets of the University Examinations for the whole of BDS Course.
- (e) Completion of Internship certificate.
- (f) Registration certificate from the Kerala State Dental Council.
- (g) Document (School Record viz: SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- (h) Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last studied.
- (i) Conduct certificate from the Principal of the Dental College where the candidate last studied.
- (j) Migration Certificate from the respective University (if applicable).
- (k) Candidate shall remit the tuition fees and other applicable fees at the time of admission.
- (l) Passport size photographs (10 copies).
- (m) A Physical Fitness Certificate in the format given in Annexure III obtained from a Medical Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.
- (n) Community certificate (if applicable)
- (o) Non-creamy layer Certificate (if applicable)
- (p) Income Certificate (if applicable)
- (q) Dependent Certificate (if applicable)
- (r) Originals of other certificates, the copies of which are enclosed with the application form.
- (s) Undertaking in Non Judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 500/- and to be notarized (Annexure II)
- (t) Any other document/ certificate required to be produced.

**For NRI Quota, the following additional documents are to be submitted:**

- a) **Passport copy and Visa/Green Card/OCI Documents/Norka Roots ID** of their respective sponsors attested by the embassy. The Job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents. The Visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the Medical and Allied Courses.
- b) **Employment certificate:** In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/ Consulate authorities.
- c) **Relationship Certificate:** The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms) No.243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.
- d) **Notarised Sworn Affidavit:** The Candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarised by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent (\*) of the sponsor and the all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor
- e) **Documents to prove Citizenship:** The sponsor should be an Indian citizen/Overseas Citizen of India/Person of Indian Origin and relevant document to prove the same

*Note: All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status/ Non Creamy Layer /Minority etc. shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.*

*Candidates will not be given any extension of time to produce the original documents/certificates.*

*\*"An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father/ Mother/Brothers & Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted father or adopted mother working abroad"*

## 5.1 Cancellation of admission/Refund of Fees

- (i). No request for refund of fees received within a period of five days prior to the date of closure of admission to the BDS course fixed by the National Dental Commission/any competent authority appointed by the Govt. of India/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India will be entertained. Refund of fees will be applicable only to students who leave the College on or before the above-referred date. The refund will be made within thirty days of the receipt of request thereof
- (ii). If any candidate discontinues the course or leaves the Institution after the last date of joining notified by the CEE or discontinues the course/leaves the institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e fees for the whole course and also shall refund the stipend already received. They will have to pay Liquidated damages as stipulated in Clause 19.5 of the Government of Kerala Prospectus for Admission to the Post-Graduate Courses in Dental Surgery (MDS– Master of Dental Surgery)- 2026. In such cases the documents in original submitted by the candidate at the time of admission and other documents like Transfer Certificate in original to be issued by the college will be released only after payment of all dues including the fees for the remaining years.
- (ii). In addition to the above, such students will have to pay hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college. For the purpose of calculations of proportionate recovery part of a month will be considered as a full month.

## VI. METHOD OF TRAINING

6.1 Training of Post Graduates will not only hospital-based, but also community-oriented. Post-graduate training shall consist of training of the students through lectures, seminars, journal clubs, group discussions, participation in laboratory and experimental work, involvement in research, clinical meetings, grand rounds, clinicopathological conferences, practical training in the diagnosis and medical and surgical treatment, training in the basic medical sciences as well as in allied clinical specialties, etc. as per the requirement of Speciality training.

Specialities where patient treatment is involved the teaching and training of the students, shall include graded responsibility in the management and treatment of patients entrusted to their care.

6.2 Training will also include outreach community programmes and rotation postings of Post Graduate students in the hospitals/health centers of the Muslim Educational Society.

6.3 **Private Practice:** Post Graduate students are not permitted to engage in private practice during the course period. Students admitted to the Master of Dental Surgery (MDS) programme shall comply with the private practice regulations prescribed in the Government of Kerala Prospectus for admission to the Post- Graduate Courses in Dental Surgery (MDS– Master of Dental Surgery) - 2026.

- 6.4. **NDC Biometric Attendance:** No PG student is allowed to appear in the University PG Examinations, if the biometric attendance is less than 80%. Minimum 80% biometric attendance is required for all Postgraduate students as per regulations 18(a)(i) of DCI MDS course regulations, 2017 and as per the NDC order no. NDC/DARB/14/Bio-Metric/2026/M-1032 dated 30-06-2026,

## VII. ATTENDANCE & LEAVE

- 7.1 Students admitted to the Master of Dental Surgery (MDS) programme shall comply with the attendance and leave regulations prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), National Dental Commission (NDC) as amended from time to time.

## VIII DISCIPLINE

- 8.1 Rules and regulations as prescribed should be strictly followed at the college, hospital and hostels.
- 8.2 Smoking and consumption of alcoholic drinks are totally prohibited.
- 8.3 Hostel accommodation is provided for one year, renewable after assessment of the discipline of the student on a yearly basis.
- 8.4 Daily biometric attendance marking is mandatory for the hostel students, failing to comply with regulations will forfeit their hostel accommodation.
- 8.5 **Uniform & Dress Code:** Students are expected to obey the dress code of the College. Jeans, Baggies, T-Shirts and the likes are not permitted to be worn inside the hospital/College campus. Medical scrubs are prescribed for MDS students and have to wear them during clinical hours
- 8.6 No students shall wear face veil or any other garments that completely covers the face and renders personal identification difficult or impossible while on the campus or during institutional activities. All the students should wear overcoat and ID card compulsorily. ***All students shall maintain modesty and decency in their attire while on the Campus. Students are not allowed to attend the classes or participate in academic or institutional activities wearing garments that completely cover their face and prevent proper identification.*** The management reserves the right to take appropriate disciplinary action against those who do not comply with the college dress code (vide judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.P.(C).No.35293 of 2018 dated 04- 12-2018).

8.7 There will be regular value oriented classes/discussions in the campus. Students are advised to participate in these programmes. This is an institution meant for higher learning and its objective is not only to impart education but also to build the character of the students and transform them into better human beings.

8.8 Students are expected to observe absolute discipline in their conduct, dignity and decorum during the entire period they spend in the institution. Failure to observe absolute discipline, dignity and decorum will invite appropriate disciplinary action.

8.9 Ragging is strictly prohibited. If it is found during the admission or any time there after that the applicant has indulged in ragging admission shall be refused or the student shall be expelled from the institution. Whoever commits, participate in, abets or propagate ragging within or outside the institution shall be suspended from the institution with immediate effect and the Dean/Principal shall report the matter to the civil/police authorities.

#### 8.10 RAGGING

**Important :** According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.

All institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principal's, College, Kerala & Ors [with SLP (C ) No.24296-99/2004 & W.P.(Crl) No.173/2006 & SLP (C ) No.14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honorable Supreme Court of India for effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions.

In case, the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/ she indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/ she shall be expelled from the educational institution.

Each of the student of the institution and his/ her parents, or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the time of registration/ admission in prescribed format available in **Annexure IV** which is mandatory for registration/ admission.

Such an undertaking shall be submitted before the commencement of every academic year. An undertaking similar to the above shall be submitted every year by the student who is admitted to the hostel.

## **I. GENERAL**

- a) No TA or other allowance will be paid for any purpose connected with Selection and Admission.
- b) All candidates who are selected for admission should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis A and B before admission. A certificate to this effect will have to be produced at the time of admission/before commencement of the course.
- c) Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college <https://mesdc.edu.in/> regularly for announcements and instructions. No separate communication will be sent in this connection
- d) Medium of instruction will be English.
- e) Any other matters not specifically covered in this Prospectus shall be decided by the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna and the decision of that authority shall be final and binding on all concerned.

## **II. REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES**

Any grievances/ complaints regarding selection and admission can be brought to the notice of the management of the MES Dental College, Perinthalmanna within 24 hours of occurrence of the grievance.
